Approval of SATAjet RP/SATAjet RP Digital 2 Spray Guns

In response to an e-mail dated January 27, 2004, from Suzanne Walters regarding approval of the above subject spray guns, the Shasta County Air Quality Management District offers the following as official approval:

Please be advised that the Shasta County Air Quality Management District will authorize the use of any spray coating equipment that can demonstrate at least 65 percent transfer efficiency under the conditions of its use. The material from the South Coast AQMD that you provided with your letter of December 23, 2003, indicates that your spray gun is capable of meeting this standard. Therefore, our District will authorize the use the two subject SATAjet guns in Shasta County subject to the same conditions as those mentioned by the South Coast Air Quality Management District in their letter dated November 25, 2003.
